Update history



This document contains details of all changes to the EURING2000 code which have been made since the final PDF version of 29 October 2008. 1	new or growing
U	unknown whether new or old

Thus typical codes may be U10, 110, 111 etc. Always use U for the smallest feather if it cannot be found to ensure there are exactly three characters in this code.

Species codes - Bats Appendix 2

A number of new species codes have been added to cover all species known to occur in Europe and all newly discovered/split species - these have codes 50370 - 50480. Also added are codes for newly split species 50121, 50132; 50211, 50212; 50311, 50312 and codes bats of known genus but unidentified species (50069, 50169, 50209, 50239, 50299, 50339).

Codes 51000 - 51999 have now been reserved for groups of species where identification may not be certain but is closer than just to the genus. Codes 51000 - 51130 have been defined.

Codes 52000 - 59999 are now reserved for world bats.
