Bird-ringing results in Slovakia in 2006

In 2006, 52 members of Slovak Ornithological Society/BirdLife Slovakia ringed altogether 27.328 birds, of them 3.525 were nestlings (12,9 %). The most numerous ringed species were Sylvia atricapilla (3.192 ex.), Erithacus rubecula (2.640 ex.), Coccothraustes coccothraustes (1.558 ex.), Fringilla coelebs (1.354 ex.) and Phylloscopus collybita (1.186 ex.). The ringed birds belonged to 163 species.
