Organisation:

The Ornithology Laboratory was founded at The Entomology Station of The Romanian Research Institute for Agriculture on June 1st, 1936. Later on, in 1939, The Ornithology Laboratory was turned into the Romanian Ornithological Centre, with an independent status within The Institute for Plant Protection in Bucharest, dependent on The Agriculture and Forestry Science Academy.

Rings

There are 11 sizes/types of aluminium rings and 6 types of steel rings used at present. Both rings and nets were bought from the Aranea company (Poland). Rings are given to ringers for free.

Computerization:

Since 1993 all the ringing data have been computerized and the ringing data between 1939-1993 are still processed. The implementation of a computer assisted program including ringing and recapture data is utterly requested to enable ringers to get an easy access to such information.

Haliaetus albicilla. Blue aluminium ring code(xxx) (x=digits 0 to 9). *Phalacrocorax carbo sinensis.* Green ring imprinted with white letters (AAA). *Ciconia ciconia.* White ring with black code (Exxx) (x=digits 0 to 9). *Falco vespertinus.* White ring with black code (xxo) (x=digits 0 to 9).
