

MADRID-ICONA Bird Ringing Scheme

Report for the EURING General Assembly 2011 in Malta

1. Organisation

The Madrid-ICONA Bird Ringing Scheme (ESI) is part of the Spanish Ministry of Environment (Oficina de Especies Migratorias – OEM). The Ringing Scheme is being financed by the Ministry of Environment. Since 1990 it is being managed by SEO/BirdLife (Spanish partner of BirdLife International), by means of variable length contracts.

2. Staff

The staff is conformed, at present, by 3 full-time positions: one phD as a Coordinator, one computer specialist as a Database administrator and one non-Academic as an Assistant. The administrative head at the Ministry of Environment is Dr. Ricardo Gómez-Calmaestra.

3. Ringers

During 2011, the OEM has licensed 1, 228 ringers, members of ringing groups. Training (by means of courses and field experience), evaluation (by means of exams) and subsequent control of ringers are delegated onto four scientific organisations (SEO/BirdLife, Institut Català d'Ornitologia, Estación Biológica de Doñana, and Grup Balear d'Ornitologia). The number of ringers has increased in the last years.

4. Rings

Madrid-ICONA rings are supplied free of cost to licensed ringers. Currently, there are 17 different ring types (size and material). The Swedish company Mekaniskä and the British company Porzana Ltd. manufactured the rings.

5. Ringing projects

No ringing projects are being co-ordinated by the OEM, since this task is also delegated to the four organisations mentioned. Constant Effort Sites programmes and other migration and species specific projects are currently being developed by those organisations. The Ministry of Environment financies part of the Constant Effort Sites programme since 2006. Nowadays, new applications based on ringing data are being implemented by OEM, such as an early warning

system to detect exotic and invasive bird species in Spain or indicators related to bird population trends.
